PRRT & HS ANNUAL MEETING VENDOR POLICY —

1. Sales of vendor tables will only be made to SOCIETY members before May 1st with a limit of two tables to a vendor. After May 1st if any tables are left they will be sold on a first come first serve basis.
2. During each day of the meeting the vendor room will be open one hour before the scheduled time for VENDOR SET UP ONLY. This will be strictly enforced.
3. Vendors will be required to stay at their assigned tables. There will be no swapping or changing of positions or locations permitted.
4. The vendor room will be closed during Business Meetings.
5. All questions and problems that arise from the vendors will be handled by the chairman of the vendor room. The decision of the vendor chairman is final. Questions of this nature are not to be brought before the officers and/or board of the SOCIETY unless done so by the vendor chairman on behalf of an individual.

ATTENTION MODELERS -
