Program Information

AMTRAK'S Bernard E. Britcher C. & S. training facility - AMTRAK will take the first 150 people who register and express an interest on a tour of this facility. First you will receive a short class room session on how a signal system, interlocking, and other communication systems work. Then you will be given a hands on look at the various systems as they are set up on model boards and plants. Both the original style P.R.R. relay type systems and the new solid state controls will be covered. If you have an interest in this aspect of the railroad, this is a tour you will not want to miss. The training facility is right next to the Days Inn, next to the main building of the Lancaster AMTRAK station. You can easily make the one block walk over the tracks for this tour.

STRASBURG RAILROAD EXCURSION - A specially chartered train with double headed steam power for the P.R.R.T. & H.S. Power for the train will be D16sb #1223 and E2 #7002 for this special train, and the consist will include the P-70 coach from the Railroad Museum of Pennsylvania. If evening light permits a photo runby will also be held for those riding the train. Please note that this train is after regular Strasburg operations have closed for the day and this train is not open to the general public. The Strasburg R.R. reserves the right to substitute motive power as mechanical conditions permit, but two steam locomotives are guaranteed.

MIDNIGHT MOVIES - A room will be provided for those wishing to "show what they brought" that may be used all Friday night. The Days Inn will provide a screen, a projector cart, and seating for 75 people. It is up to the individual wishing to show something to provide their own projector and/or audio visual equipment. A sign up list will be provided in the room to set up some kind of order.

PROGRAM A - 1361: On The Road Again Dan Cupper, former reporter for the HARRISBURG PATRIOT NEWS and former editor for the Pennsylvania High Speed Intercity Rail Passenger Commission will cover the restoration of K4s #1361 that put the engine back in service after being a familiar landmark on HORSESHOE CURVE for many years. Views of work being done in the Juniata Shops highlight this program along with shots of the engine back in service. Dan currently serves on the board of the Railroaders Memorial Museum in Altoona and has a voice in the future of the 1361.

PROGRAM B - The P.R.R. and its Service to the Union The P.R.R. played an important role for the Northern States during the American Civil War. Ivan Frantz will cover not only the railroads involvement in the war effort and its contribution to the Union, but also the effect that military action had on the railroad. It was the Civil War that shaped the P.R.R. into the great transportation system that was to emerge during the latter part of the 19th century.

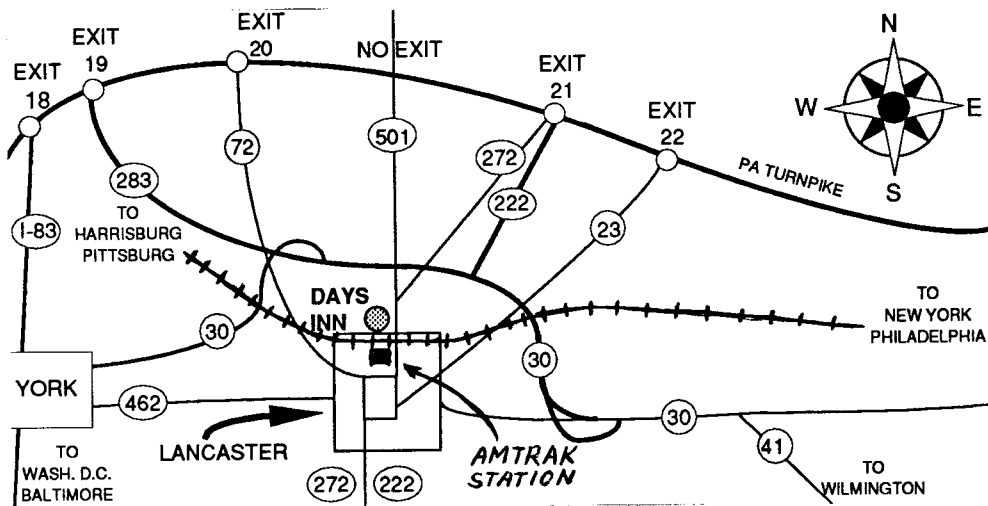
